

Elegant Halloween Wreath

SUPPLIES

- Cardboard approx 18" square
- Old silk flowers, e.g. roses, etc.
- Plastic spiders, flies and web from bargain store
- Black matt spray paint
- Black 2" ribbon
- 4" string.
- Duct tape
- Utility knife
- Glue gun



Assembly:

1. Cut a circle from the cardboard to measure approx 18"
2. Cut a circle inside the circle to measure approx 11" to form the wreath
3. Pull off the heads of the flowers from the stems and trim off the plastic backs
4. Glue flowers evenly around the cardboard wreath
5. Spray flowers with black matt spray paint, let some colour come through, then let dry
6. Glue the spiders and flies to the flowers tucking them in and around the petals
7. Hang a spider from a thread in the middle of the wreath
8. Tie a ribbon into a bow and fix with glue to the bottom of the wreath
9. Stretch cobwebbing material lightly to the flowers
10. Glue a loop of string to the back of the wreath and secure with duct tape.
